We proudly serve hand-crafted cocktails, wine, and local beer from Manor Hill Brewing. Our beer garden is a unique outdoor experience located just across the street along the Tiber Branch. At Manor Hill Tavern, we are committed to serving the community. Each month we feature three different charitable organizations in our "Thoughtful Thursday" promotion to highlight local groups and their outreach. On Tuesday evenings, we have a Run Club that meets for a run along the Trolley Trail and then gathers for a beer or two!
